**Subject: Revised Rules/guidelines (MQS) for issuance of participation certificate and governing rules for conducting Indian Round Archery Competitions of various age group.**

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am directed by the Secretary General, AAI to communicate you that matters relating to the eligibility criteria (MQS) for issuance of participation certificates for National Championships across various age groups, as well as the rules governing the conduct of Indian Round Archery Competitions, was reviewed and deliberated in detail during the Executive Committee Meeting and the General Council Meeting held at Hyderabad in December, 2025. The members unanimously resolved to implement the following key decisions aimed at promoting uniformity, improving operational efficiency, and strengthening competitive standards which shall be implemented with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2026 and shall apply to all forthcoming National Championships/domestic competitions.-

### 1. Rules for Issuance of Participation Certificates & MQS Norms

The revised Minimum Qualifying Scores (MQS) norms for the issuance of Participation Certificates to participants in National Championships across various categories and divisions have been finalized, replacing the existing rules of the Archery Association of India (AAI) which are attached for information and execution.

### 2. Revision of Indian Round Competition Rules

It has been decided that Indian Round competitions shall be conducted at a single lower distance, as detailed below, for more details, please refer to attached document:

Senior Indian Round	2 X 30 Mtrs	6 Arrows in 180 sec	80 cm target face with 6-rings
Junior Indian Round	2 X 30 Mtrs		
Sub-Junior Indian Round	2 X 20 Mtrs		
Under 15 Indian Round	2 X 20 Mtrs		
Under 13 Indian Round	1 X 20 Mtrs	3 Arrows in 90 sec	122 cm target face
Under 10 Indian Round	1 X 15 Mtrs
