Subject: Team Selection – World Cup Stage 3 and Selection Trial for World Cup Stage 4 – Spain & World Championship – Korea.

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is to inform all concerned about the AAI Selection Committee's decisions regarding team selection for the upcoming Archery World Cups.

Previously communicated, the selection trials conducted earlier were specifically for the USA World Cup Stage 1 and China World Cup Stage 2. A separate trial was initially planned for the Turkey World Cup Stage 3 and Spain World Cup Stage 4.

However, due to unforeseen visa issues for the USA World Cup Stage 1, the Selection Committee convened to reconsider India's participation in the World Cup Stage 3 in Antalya, Turkey.

Furthermore, the committee reviewed the deadline for final entries for World Cup Stage 3, which falls on 13th May, 2025. Considering the team's scheduled return from World Cup Stage 2 on 12th May, 2025, conducting trials for Stage 3 was deemed logistically unfeasible due to potential athlete fatigue and other logistical challenges.

Therefore, the Selection Committee has decided to send the same team composition to the World Cup Stage 3 in Antalya that represented India in World Cup Stages 1 and 2.

Looking ahead, fresh selection trials will be held from 12th to 15th June 2025, at ASI, Pune, to select the team for World Cup Stage 4 in Spain and the World Championships in Korea.

The selection process for World Cup Stage 4 and the World Championships will be announced and uploaded on the AAI website soon.

All affiliated State Associations and Associate Members are requested to take note of this information and disseminate it to all eligible and interested Archers
