Subject: Revised Notification - Para Selection Trial for VI 1/2/3 for the 2026 World Archery Para Series (Czech Republic) - Rescheduled at SAI, NCOE Sonipat.

Dear Sir/Madam

This is in continuation of AAI's earlier notifications issued vide Ref. No. AAI/SelectionTrial/WAPS-CZ/2026 dated April 18, 2026, and the subsequent communication dated April 22, 2026. Vide the said communications, the Selection Trial for Visually Impaired Athletes (VI 1/2/3) for the 2026 World Archery Para Series to be held at Nove Mesto nad Metuji, Czech Republic from 26th June to 5th July 2026 was first notified, and subsequently cancelled upon information that the VI category event had been withdrawn from the competition programme.

The Archery Association of India has since received confirmation from the Local Organising Committee (LOC), Nove Mesto nad Metuji, that the VI category has been reinstated in the competition programme, with the competition to be conducted under a "combined" sport class format. Accordingly, the Selection Trial for the VI 1/2/3 category is hereby rescheduled.

The Selection trial to Select the Archer of VI 1/2/3 Category for the 2026 World Archery Para Series to be held in Nove Mesto nad Metuji, Czech Republic from 26th of June to 5th of July 2026 will be held at SAI, NCOE Sonipat, Haryana on 20th May, 2026. Archers who are Nationally & Internationally classified are only allowed in the said trial.

Selection Procedure -The shooting distance for the trial will be 30 meters. There will be two ranking rounds, and selection will be based on the performance in these rounds.

All the participating Archers and accompanying officials will have to make their own boarding and lodging arrangements. The Archery Association of India will provide ground facilities for the trials.

All entries should come through Member State Associations/Associate Members. No individual entries shall be entertained. All State Associations/Associate Members are required to send their entries through 'Tournament Manager' only on or before 17th May, 2026. No entries after the deadline will be accepted.

All State Associations/Associate Members are requested to bring this notification to the immediate notice of all concerned Archers and Coaches.
