We are pleased to inform you that the Archery Association of India (AAI) shall be conducting a Recurve Coaches' Workshop by inviting a foreign expert, Mr. Yusuf Göktuğ Ergin, Head Coach and Technical Director of the Turkey Archery National Team under the NTPC DPR Dhanurvidya Project.

The workshop will be held at Jaipur, Rajasthan, from 11th to 16th March, 2026.

Arrival : 11th March, 2026
Session : 12th to 15th March, 2026
Departure : 16th March, 2026

The Coaches' Committee has approved the following eligibility criteria for participation in the Recurve Coaches' Workshop:

- Only coaches who have successfully completed the AAI Level-1 or AAI Level 2 Coaches' Workshop shall be eligible to apply.
- The coach must be registered on the AAI Portal with valid and updated credentials. All applications must be duly recommended by the concerned State / UT Archery Association through the prescribed process.
- A maximum of three (3) coaches per State / UT shall be permitted to participate in the workshop. However, it is on the discretion of the AAI to take a call on it.
- Offline, late, or incomplete applications shall not be accepted under any circumstances.
- State / UT Archery Associations are requested to ensure that nominations are forwarded strictly in accordance with the eligibility conditions.
- All entries must be submitted only through the official AAI online portal on or before 28th February, 2026.

The detailed policy for the selection of coaches for the Coaches' Workshop under the Foreign Coach Policy is already uploaded on the AAI website and attached with this circular. Further details regarding the workshop schedule and logistical arrangements shall be communicated separately in due course.

All participating coaches shall strictly adhere to AAI discipline, workshop guidelines, and code of conduct throughout the programme.

AAI reserves the right to amend or modify the policy in the interest of archery development, with due notification.

This circular is issued with the approval of the competent authority.
