#### Recurve, Compound & Indian Round (M&W)

##### A) RECURVE - QUALIFICATION EVENT (MEN & WOMEN)

##### RECURVE - ELIMINATION ROUND (INDIVIDUAL)

Elimination rounds are played up to 5 sets of 3 arrows in their respective distances. If an Archer wins a set they receive two points; if the set is drawn the competitors receive one point each. If a competitor has not won a majority of the sets, the outcome is decided by a single arrow shoot-off with the competitor closest to the middle being declared the winner. The first Archer who achieved six set points wins.

##### RECURVE - ELIMINATION ROUND (TEAM & MIXED TEAM)

The set system consists of 4 sets of 6 arrows for teams and in the case of mixed teams 4 sets of 4 arrows are used. The high score for the set takes two set points. For a tie, the points are split. The first team to reach 5 set points wins, so there would be a shootoff in case of a 4-4 tie.

In the event of a tie, each team member will shoot one arrow each. The team will have 1 minute to shoot the 3 arrows. The team with the highest total score is the winner. If still tied, an arrow closest to the center of the target wins; if these are the same distance from the center the team with the second arrow closest arrow is the winner, and the third if need be.

**"Note: Since the Under 10 and Under 13 age categories are open tournaments, AAI will only conduct individual elimination rounds. No team or mixed team events will be conducted by AAI."**

### COMPOUND - ELIMINATION ROUND (INDIVIDUAL)

Compound matches are decided using cumulative scoring in 50 mtrs. Athletes shoot 15 arrows in five ends of three arrows. The athlete with the highest 15-arrow score wins the match. In case of tie, the outcome is decided by a single arrow shoot-off with the competitor closest to the middle being declared the winner.

### COMPOUND - ELIMINATION ROUND (TEAM & MIXED TEAM)

Compound team and mixed team matches are also decided using cumulative scoring. A team (consisting of three) match consists of 4 ends of each archer shooting 2 arrows, making 24 arrows in total. The team with the highest 24-arrow total wins the match. The team has 2 minutes to shoot all 6 arrows. Mixed teams shoot 16 arrows in four ends of four arrows; the mixed team with the highest 16-arrow total wins the match.

In the event of a tie, each team member will shoot one arrow each. The team will have 1 minute to shoot the 3 arrows. The team with the highest total score is the winner. If still tied, an arrow closest to the center of the target wins; if these are the same distance from the center the team with the second arrow closest arrow is the winner, and the third if need be.

**Indian Round - New Rules**

Updated rule of the Indian Round as approved in the General Council Meeting of the Archery Association of India held at Hyderabad, Telangana, on 18<sup>th</sup> December, 2025.

**INDIAN ROUND - ELIMINATION ROUND (INDIVIDUAL)**

Elimination rounds are played up to 5 sets of 3 arrows on the same target face in which qualification round was conducted in each age round (For Under 10-15 mtrs, Under 13-20 mtrs, Under 15-20 mtrs, Sub-Junior-20 mtrs, Junior-30 mtrs & Senior-30 mtrs). If a competitor wins a set they receive two points; if the set is drawn the competitors receive one point each. The first Archer who achieved six set points wins. If the set points are 5-5 after 5 sets completed, the outcome is decided by a single arrow shoot-off for score. If the score is the same, the arrow closest to the centre of the target face will resolve the tie. If the distance is the same, successive single arrow shoot-offs will be conducted until the tie is resolved.

**INDIAN ROUND - ELIMINATION ROUND (TEAM & MIXED TEAM)**

The set system consists of 4 sets of 6 arrows for teams and in the case of mixed team 4 sets of 4 arrows are used in same distances as individual events. The high score for the set takes two set points. For a tie the points are split. The first team to reach 5 set points wins, so there would be a shootoff in case of a 4-4 tie.

In the event of a tie, a three-arrow (two-arrow for Mixed Team) shoot-off for score, a single arrow by each team member. If the score is tied, the team with the arrow closest to the centre will win. If still tied, the second arrow (or third) closest to the centre will determine the winner. If the tie cannot be resolved, successive shoot-offs will be conducted until the tie is resolved.
